The COVID-19 outbreak has left a unbearable impact on the tourism scenario of Assam. It has also led a crippling blow to the global tourism and associated sectors. The World Travel & Tourism Council (WTTC) estimates that 75 million travel and tourism jobs are at risk globally due to COVID19 pandemic. The Indian scenario is also not satisfactory with the assessment by Confederation of Indian Industries (CII) of an impact of around 60-65% of projected revenue of \$28 billion from October 2019-March 2020 in the tourism sector. Assam is one among the hard-hit states with regard to the tourism industry. The whole tourism value chain across hotels, restaurants, resorts, travel agencies, tour operators as well as dhabas and fast food businesses directly or indirectly associated with the tourism sector in the state have seriously threatened. Under the backdrop of such a critical juncture, as academician, it is our pure duty to do something about it as it is the high time to sort out a future course of action and an effective parameter to revive our tourism sector.
